

# Attention University Community!!!

If driving is a necessity and you need to have a car on campus, we urge you to purchase a parking permit. The City's recent move to stricter enforcement of neighborhood permit parking regulations, and the addition of many more parking meters on the streets of Lincoln Park, make the DePaul parking permit a very reasonable alternative to the risk and cost associated with being ticketed or towed.

## DePaul University Parking Permits 2009/2010 Parking Rates

All vehicles using the Lincoln Park Campus parking lots and garages must display a valid DePaul parking permit. Vehicles that do not display a valid parking permit will be towed immediately at the owner's expense. Purchasers of the 24-hour/day permit will be allowed access into the Sheffield parking facility and the Clifton parking deck at no extra charge. The Sheffield and Clifton facilities are open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

A limited number of individually reserved assigned parking spaces are available in the heated Sanctuary Garage. Reservations for these spaces are open to all DePaul students, faculty and staff on a first-come, first-serve basis. To request one of these spaces contact Parking Services at (773) 325-7275. Reservations will be held until Aug. 31, 2009.

The evening permit is valid only after 4 p.m. Monday through Friday and all day Saturdays and Sundays. The free evening permit is valid for surface lot parking but access to the Clifton Parking Deck can be added for a \$100.00 fee. To park in a university lot during peak demand times (8 a.m. to 4 p.m.), a 24 hour/day permit is required. Permits do not guarantee the holder a parking space, only the opportunity to enter a specified lot to seek an authorized parking space.

## Ordering Your Parking Permit

1. Determine which permit you will need.
2. Go to the Parking Services website <http://parkingservices.depaul.edu/forms/index.asp>. Find the permit application you want. You can type the data onto the form, print and sign it or print the form first and complete the application. Please be sure to include your ID number and **all** of your vehicle information.
3. If you are ordering a 24 hour/day permit for Lincoln Park, fill in the payment section on the bottom of the application and remit the appropriate amount by check or credit card. Please do not send cash. Make checks payable to DePaul University.
4. Return the signed application and payment to: DePaul Central/Payment Center, 2320 N. Kenmore Ave. Rm. 101, Chicago, Illinois 60614-3298.

You will receive your permit via mail prior to the beginning of the academic school year.  
Walk-up permit sales begin Monday, July 6, 2009, at the Lincoln Park Payment Center.

**Parking enforcement will begin Thursday, Sept. 17, 2009**

\*\* The cost to replace a lost or stolen permit is \$20. Any vehicle found using a lost or stolen permit will be towed immediately at the owner's expense. If you lose your permit or leave it in a different car, please contact Parking Services immediately.
